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H-270.960 Inappropriate Legislative Mandates of eGFR Calculations

Our AMA supports the position that (1) the estimated Glomerular Filtration Rate Calculation (eGFR) calculation, when appropriate and feasible, is a clinically useful calculation that should be promoted in the medical community in a scientific manner as a calculation that does NOT require state legislation or state law that would create an inflexible, politically-based mandate for the practice of medicine that, in general, can be deleterious to patient care; and (2) legislation mandating the eGFR calculation improperly and detrimentally prescribes medical decision-making to the extent that it deprives a physician of the ability to make appropriate, patient-specific clinical judgments regarding the performance of the calculation.
