




HCBS: What We Have Now in Home and Community Care

- **PACE – Program for the All-inclusive Care of the Elderly**
- **CAP/DA – Community Alternatives Program for Disabled Adults with Choice Option**
- **CAP/C – Community Alternatives Program for (Medically Fragile) Children**
- **PDN – Private Duty Nursing**
- **PCS – In-Home Personal Care Services**

Community First Choice Program

- Provides for home and community-based services and supports for eligible recipients who require institutional level of care
- Promotes consumer directed services and supports
- Provides for a 6% increase in FMAP
- Effective date is October 1, 2011

Removal of Barriers to Providing HCBS

- Referred to as 1915(i) option
- Does not require recipient to meet institutional level of care
- Gives the state an option to provide more types of HCBS through a SPA
- Extends full Medicaid benefits to recipients receiving HCBS under the state plan
- How many 1915(i) options are available to the state under PPACA?
