- The Division of Public Health was designated as the lead agency to develop a comprehensive State plan for injury prevention

# WHY a Statewide Plan?

- Build infrastructure for injury prevention in NC
- Build advocacy
- Develop policy and support initiatives
- CDC Core funding provided to states with plans
- State funding needed
- *Reduce injury and violence-related morbidity and mortality in NC.*

# Statewide Strategic Plan for Injury and Violence Prevention

- **NC Legislative mandate passed 2007, SL 187**
- **Twenty-five Key Stakeholders met Oct. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> with National Children's Safety Network and a facilitator**
- **Seven goals identified, objectives being finalized; additional stakeholders added**
- **Completion date – March/April 2009**
